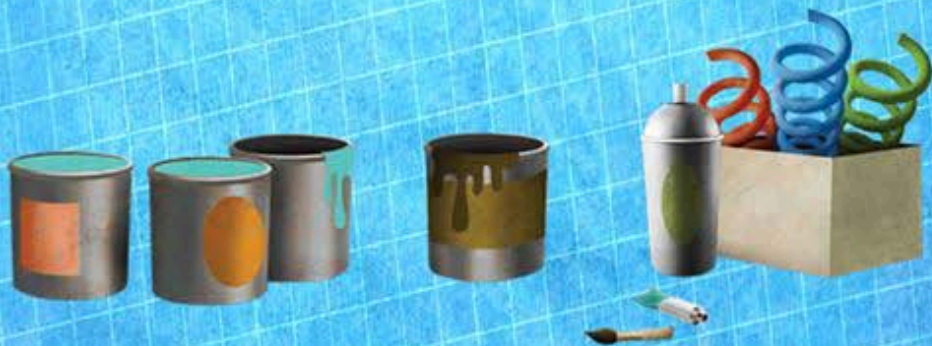


Robot-Making Challenge

Church Council Meeting minutes **June 13, 2017**

Present: Pastor Jeff, James Hiles, Mike Overman, Todd Hone, Sue Fennig, Amy Hoyng, Trisha McMurray, Sheena Stover, Jim VanTilburg, Steve Siebert, Susie Nelson, Lorna Saddler, and Vicar Fred

The meeting was called to order by President James Hiles

Opening

Opening prayers and devotions were offered by Vicar Fred Bartelt.

Secretary's Report

Minutes from the Church Council meeting on May 16, 2017 were reviewed. Jim VanTilburg moved and Todd Hone seconded to accept the secretary's report. Motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report

For the month of February

Year to date expenses are (\$227,507) more than income (\$212,081) by \$15,426

*We have 191 active giving units, with about 109 of them giving 10 times per year or more.

*We currently have 20 households utilizing recurring online giving. Nine of them are weekly, three are every other week, and eight are monthly. The total giving from these families is approximately \$7,000 per month.

*There are a number of other members that utilize online giving occasionally when they are not at church or forget their offering.

At the end of June a "Giving Statement" will be mailed out to members of the congregation to make members aware of the amount they have given and reminding them of the amount they have pledged.

Amy Hoyng moved and Susie Nelson seconded the motion to accept the finance report. Motion passed unanimously.

President's Report

Council President, James Hiles, discussed that he, Pastor Jeff, Andrea Kuehne, and Mike Overman attended the annual Synod meeting May 19 and 20, 2017. Vicar Fred attended as a guest observer. Attention of the meeting focused on attempting to develop collaboration among the congregations to encourage discussion and sharing of successful ideas for growth and stewardship.

Pastor's Report

At the annual Synod meeting there was discussion about the "Reformation 500 Anniversary Crawl" and each congregation has been asked to participate. St. John's was asked to talk about our Equipping Ministry.

Pastoral Ministry: There were Confirmations, Births, Deaths, or Weddings in June. We had one baptism, Kenneth Westerheide, on June 18, 2017.

Administrative

- A nursery committee has been established to staff the nursery with at least 2 volunteers whenever the nursery is open, and evaluate the financial feasibility of moving the nursery to allow closer access to a restroom.
- Vicar Fred's last official day was June 11, 2017
- Debbie Cowdery completed her time as office assistant/ financial secretary at the end of June. Her job description is being reviewed to make adjustments and the plan is to hire a replacement.

Youth:

- 52 youth and adults participated in the mission trip to North Carolina.

Education:

- Confirmation camp was June 18-23 at Camp Lutherwald. 13 people attended
- VBS will be August 6-10.
- New resources for confirmation classes are being evaluated. We may return to using Faith Inkubators.

Social Concerns

- The first annual Congregation Campout was held June 2-4, 2017. Approximately 60 people attended, staying on 19 campsites. A second annual Congregation Campout is being planned.
- There was an excellent turnout to the farewell potluck for Vicar Fred on June 11, 2017.

Worship

- Thank you to Pastor Doug for presiding over the Eucharist on June 4th.

Evangelism

- Relay for Life went well and there was excellent participation from members of the congregation.
- Pub Theology, which began as Vicar Fred's internship project, will continue after his departure. Todd Home, Carman and Jill Ellis have assumed leadership roles and will continue to carry this ministry forward. Andrea Kuehne is the staff liaison.

Renovation Committee

- Garman- Miller Architects will be presenting an initial concept to the Renovation committee on June 28. This, hopefully, leads us closer to presenting the concept to the congregation.

St. John Builders

- Ground has been broken for a new home.
- The builders are working on making ice cream for their annual Ice Cream Social, planned for July 16.

Internship

- Vicar Fred's last official day was June 11, 2017. Special thanks to his internship committee: Linda Siebert, Rosemary Boomhower, Tim Menchhofer, and Steve Elston. Also, a special thank you to the family that provided Fred's apartment (they wish to remain anonymous) and to the congregation for welcoming and lovingly nurturing Fred during his time in Celina.

Miscellaneous

- We continue to work with Sherry Krieger, Assistant to the Bishop, regarding a visioning retreat for the church council.

Unfinished Business:

- Review of the new Constitution is complete. There will be a second reading within the next couple months with plans for presentation and approval at the annual congregation meeting in November.

New Business:

- Discussion focused on the development of a Mutual Ministry Committee that is designed to support the Pastor (per the constitution). Pastor Jeff will let the council know his needs for this committee at the July meeting.

Adjournment and prayer:

- Lorna Saddler moved and Steve Siebert seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed unanimously. The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

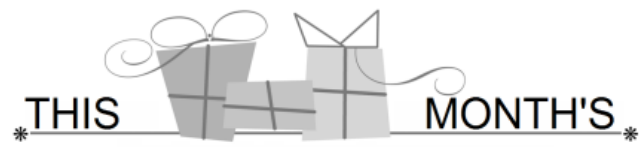
